## Job Description

Commonwealth is looking for temporary Cultural Resources Technicians to work on a project on Dixie National Forest lands in Utah. - Record using a Trimble GPS and thorough photo documentation; and
- A willingness to learn and take direction, as well as work as a team member.

A Bachelor's Degree in anthropology, archaeology, or a closely related field or field school or equivalent experience providing knowledge of archaeological survey and recordation techniques and methodology is preferred.
